Need-based scholarships are provided to deserving students who would otherwise be unable to attend school. Our social workers in Nepal meet regularly with the selected children and their parents to assist in each child's development. We dedicate our resources to each NCEF child until they complete high school (twelfth grade).

## HIGHLIGHTS.....

### Convenience for NCEF volunteers in Nepal NCEF coordinator manual

NCEF has traditionally relied on the Internet to disseminate information to its volunteers in different places in Nepal and also for volunteers to get in touch with the management team. One obvious disadvantage of this medium is the language barrier - our volunteers are more comfortable communicating in Nepali but they must read and write in English. Our expansion to far-away cities and villages has made us rethink our inter-organization communication. This year we made the area coordinator manual, a document describing all area coordinator responsibilities, available in Nepali.

Our volunteers meet the students once a month in the school or at their homes and fill out a student visit form. We have made this form available in Nepali as well. The area coordinators were given a choice of language for the form: English and Nepali. We printed the student visit forms for each student for the whole year and shipped them across the country to all the areas. Our efforts have paid off. The area coordinators feel more comfortable with their work and the direction the organization is taking.

### Local support for NCEF volunteers

Access to a computer is imperative for volunteers working in Nepal, whether to communicate with the NCEF body in the U.S. or just to type documents. Lord Buddha Education Fund, a NGO working to educate masses about Information Technology, is offering corporate assistance by allowing NCEF interns to use its computers to perform organizational tasks. This is encouraging news for the volunteers who had difficulty accessing a computer and are thankful to the Lord Buddha Education Fund.

We would also like to thank Development Resources Mobilization Network (DRMN) for donating office space to NCEF from January-July 2005 free of cost. DRMN is a development-consulting firm based in Katmandu, and their generous contribution has been immensely beneficial to NCEF's efforts.
